1. SAFETY

1.1. GENERAL

- ✓ Ensure the lamp is fully charged before initial use.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use in explosive environments.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use if floodlight or its charge cable is damaged in any way.
- ✗ **DO NOT** turn the lamp on when it is being charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** shine directly into your, other person's or an animal's eyes.
- ✗ **DO NOT** allow children to use the lamp.
- ✗ **DO NOT** handle or move the lamp whilst it is being charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use the lamp if you suspect that the battery, the lamp casing or the cable is damaged. Consult your Sealey Stockist.
- ✗ **DO NOT leave battery in a discharged state, recharge battery immediately. Before storage, fully recharge the battery, subsequently recharge the battery at least once every six months of non-use.**

1.2. BATTERY SAFETY

Four brightness levels with a maximum of 1000 lumens for controlled illumination. Sixteen total light settings combining all colour temperatures with four brightness levels. USB-C input for charging with USB output allowing the unit to operate as a power bank. Replaceable and rechargeable 3.7V 2600mAh battery delivers long performance for demanding work.

LED2000P: Sturdy rotating handle enables smooth 360° positioning for precise lighting control. Strong magnetic base allows stable hands-free use with added tripod support. Four colour temperature settings provide clear visibility for varied workshop tasks. USB-C input for charging with USB output allowing the unit to operate as a power bank. Two Replaceable and rechargeable 3.7V 2600mAh battery delivers long performance for demanding work. IP65 resistance ensures dependable operation in tough and dirty environments. Four brightness levels with a maximum of 2000 lumens for controlled illumination. Sixteen total light settings combining all colour temperatures with four brightness levels.

The battery fitted to this lamp is considered to be a consumable item and its ability to accept a charge will reduce over time. We will provide warranty against mechanical and electrical defect for a period of one year - this does not cover fair wear and tear. If the battery is not properly charged before first use, or regularly conditioned, its capacity will diminish. Under these circumstances we will not replace the battery regardless of whether it is less than one year old.

NOTE: The lithium battery does not suffer from memory effect and once fully charged may be stored for up to six months without another charge.

5. OPERATION

5.1. CHARGING

5.1.1. Insert the Micro USB plug on the USB cable into the charging port on the rear of the lamp.

5.1.2. Plug the other end of the USB cable into a 5V USB outlet.

❑ **WARNING! DO NOT** turn lamp on whilst charging.

5.1.3. The battery indicator will blink during charging.

5.1.4. When the battery has charged fully, the battery indicators will glow green.

5.2. OPERATION

5.2.1. Press On/Off scroll through power levels 25-100%, then off.

5.2.2. Press colour temperature scroll through from 6500K-2700K.

5.3. POWERBANK

5.3.1. Connect device to be powered via USB port.

5.3.2. Press On/Off button to turn on Powerbank, battery level indicator will illuminate, device will charge.

5.3.3. Press On/Off again to turn off.

6. MAINTENANCE

NOTE: There are no user replaceable parts apart from the battery. The light source can only be replaced by the manufacturer or similar qualified persons.

6.1. Clean the casing externally (not the glass) with a moist cloth.

6.2. If necessary clean the glass with an alcohol dampened soft cloth.

✖ **DO NOT** use solvents or abrasives.

✖ **DO NOT** allow unit to get wet or use/store in a damp environment.
