1. SAFETY

1.1. GENERAL

- ✓ Ensure the lamp is fully charged before initial use.
- ✗ **DO NOT** turn the lamp on when it is being charged.
- ✗ **DO NOT** shine directly into your, other person's or an animal's eyes.
- ✗ **DO NOT** allow children to use the lamp.
- ✗ **DO NOT** handle or move the lamp whilst it is being charged.

Compact worklight fits in the palm of your hand, easy to transport and store and provides impressive performance. Rotating arm features built-in magnet and rotates 360° for easy direction of light. Compact and durable construction rated to IP65 and IK07 ideal for use in any environment. Charging indicator flashes during charging via the Type C USB Cable (supplied).

5. BATTERY

5.1. CHARGING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Connect the USB cable to the charging port. Fig.1
2. Plug into a USB power source (adapter, laptop, power bank).

❑ **WARNING! DO NOT** turn lamp on whilst charging.

3. Charging indicator:

- Flashing Green = Charging
- Flashing Green goes off = Fully Charged

4. Disconnect once fully charged.

5.2. USER TIPS

Use low mode to extend battery life.

6. OPERATION

6.1. Power ON/OFF

- 6.2. Press the power button once to turn on the light.
- 6.3. Press repeatedly to cycle through lighting modes.
- 6.4. Press and hold (2–3 seconds) to turn off.

LIGHTING MODES

1. Press the ON/OFF button once to turn on the light.
2. Press the ON/OFF button repeatedly to cycle through the different lighting modes:
 - High Brightness
 - Medium Brightness
 - Low Brightness

6.5. ADJUSTING THE LIGHT

Adjust the angle of the light on its stand by rotating it up to 360° for optimal lighting. (see fig.2)

7. MAINTENANCE

- 7.1. Clean the device using a dry or slightly damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or solvents, as these may damage the surface or internal components. Ensure the charging port remains free from dust and debris to maintain proper functionality.

7.2. STORAGE

Store the device in a cool, dry place, away from moisture and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the device to prevent damage.

8. DISPOSAL

- 8.1. Dispose of the product according to local regulations for electronic waste. Do not dispose of batteries in household waste.
