## 1. SAFETY






## 5. ASSEMBLY



**Step 1.** Align the Pegboard 'A' and Pegboard Support Pillars 'B' – Hold the pegboard against the Support pillars, ensuring the pre-drilled holes align.



**Step 2.** Insert the supplied Screws and Locking Nuts – Drive screws through the Support Pillars into the Pegboard, as shown in the above illustration making sure they are tight. Insert the 2 Plastic Grommets as shown.



**Step 3.** Align the Pegboard 'A' assembly up with the back of bench. Align the predrilled holes and screw the pegboard to the bench as illustrated. Tighten bolts to finish.
